Baby Bitch (2)

1st Troublend Now or Never Mr T Cannon & Ms J Manicome-Torry
1 off 2 classes, I was a bit concerned to judge, but in the end how enjoyable it was. A extremely pretty brindle baby, very nice female head, short coupled, stood 4 square, good angulation, moved very nicely, should have plenty of winning years ahead.

2nd Keltrice X Factor J O'Donnell

12 weeks old, another bonny baby, white pied, very similar to the 1st.
pleasant head, true front, and correct bite, moved well both ways.

Minor Bitch (3)

1st Taino Princess Snowflake L & C Doorakers

What a bonny lass, white puppy, feminine head, neat ears, short coupled, good bend of stifle, moved very nicely, I'm sure more red cards will be won.

2nd Westrova Stoic Sexy Sadie F J Strover

Brindle with, striking white front, well boned, attractive head, good back end moved very nicely.

3rd Castlebar Believe it or Not Mrs R Bawden

Brindle, slightly more mature than 1st & 2nd, more terrier head, straight front, powerful neck, with short level back, coat in beautiful condition.

Puppy Bitch (3)

1st Brohez Black Art M Jones

The puppy of the day, brindle, with excellent head shape, straight, front, short coupled, good rib cage, nice expression, moved and handled very nicely, sure to have more red cards, what a lucky owner.

Best Puppy in Show.

2nd Xamrik Rogue N Temple,

White with red markings, powerful girl, straight front, and good head piece, short coupled just a tiny bit overweight.

3rd Costalot Blazing Summer M Jones

A nice red, with straight front, terrier head, correct bite, clean neckline, just a bit shy, sure to mature into a nice bitch.

Junior Bitch (4, 1)

1st Ch. Alport Black Diamond (IMP Uk) L Kavanagh

Black brindle, excellent quality brindle bitch, classic head, round eyes, correct bite, neat ears, short back, good strong back end, moved very nicely, **Res CC**

2nd Neworder She's a Knockout F J Strover

White with black eye patch, defined head stop, straight front, good rib cage, well angulated back end, moved ok.

3rd Pickaxe Paws for Applause A Robinson

Red bitch, with pleasant head, correct bite, short coupled body, level back on the move. Just wasn't relaxed.

Intermediate Bitch (3)

1st Stafforce Miss Magdalene Ms L Honey

Brindle with qualities, in good condition, possessing clean neat head, short coupled body, moved very nicely.

2nd Westrova Stoic Summer Rayne F J Strover

Lovely coloured tiger brindle, strong feminine head, well balanced body, level topline on the move, moved ok.

3rd Pickaxe Red Temptress Ms K A Lee

A very nice red and white bitch, nice head, dark eyes, straight front, good hindquarters, moved nicely.

State Bred Bitch (5)

1st Ch Akinos Summer Storm N Kesic

This was a lovely class of quality bitches.

My girl of the day, excellent quality bitch, brindle with white markings on powerful chest, good head stop, correct bite, level top, good rib cage, good bend in stifle.

Bitch C.C. Best Bitch in show

2nd Tiagra Fifth Element Mr D Ong

Another smart quality brindle, decent head, straight front, well shaped body, preferred the head on the winner, moved very nicely.

3rd Jomaldun Chelseas Miracle Mrs A Leggo

White bitch classic, head, short coupled, good angulation, moved ok.

Australian Bred Bitch (4)

1st Ch Stitchthat Enna Siara Ms J Jenkinson

Brindle with cracking head, dark round eyes, tight lips, straight front, body in fit gleaming condition, good bend of stifle.

2nd Trueblend Devas Daughter (AI) Mr T Cannon

& Ms J Manicombe-Torry

Carries all the virtues of the winner, with quality head, lovely expression, and nice body in gleaming condition.

3rd Ch Artisinal the Pawn Queen Mrs K & Mr G Mccaughey

& Mrs R Bawden

Another white with black markings, compact bitch, pleasant head, straight front, short coupled body, moved ok.

Open Bitch (8, 2)

1st Ch Highbourne Makybe Diva Ms D J Townsend

Beautiful brindle bitch, strong clean head, dark eyes, short coupled in cracking condition.

2nd Ch Crossguns Lady Madonna (IMP UK) F J Strover

Tiger brindle, striking head, correct bite, straight front, ample rib cage, well angulated hindquarters.

3rd Ch Castlebar Strip Search Mrs R Bawden

Another nice bitch from this kennel, topsize brindle, feminine head, strong boned, short coupled body, good bend of stifle. Moved well.

Open Neuter Bitch (2)

1st Ch Castlebar Wish Upon a Star (AI) Mrs R Bawden

2nd GRD Ch Orazz Bitter Sweet Mrs R Bawden

Baby Dog (3, 1)

1st Pranksta Takn Care Obusiness M Jones

The other class I was a bit concerned about judging, dark brindle, compact baby, has a decent head, and short back, moved very well could have a promising future.

2nd Hemanakah Espiridion Mrs T Hancock

Red also very pleasant, once again carries all the virtues of the winner, maturity beat him on the day.

Minor Dog (3)

1st Castlebar Rise N Shine Mrs R Bawden

Another smart brindle, he has a strong foreface, dark eyes, strong neck, good muscle tone, level on the move.

2nd Castlebar The Confederate Mrs R Bawden

The litter brother to the 1st and very similar not as compact as winner but with maturity, he might reverse placing. Well done once again to this kennel, and all concerned.

3rd Koendidda White Gold Mr J Mrs K N Johnson

White with red markings, I quite liked this pup; the problem was he was far too uptight to assess home properly, a bit ringcraft and who knows. Nether less he is a handsome pup.

Puppy Dog (3)

1st Westrova Stoic Rocky Raccoon F J Strover

Brindle with white markings, topsize pup, decent head, straight front, level topline on the move, moved ok.

2nd Usherin Sacre Bleu M D & C D Darragh

White pied, pleasant head & body, short coupled moved ok.

3rd Brookstreet Skah Bandit (AI) A Robinson
White with red markings, straight front, good head neat ears, moved well.
Very little to separate between the 3 pups.

Junior Dog (4, 1)

1st Akinos Makin A Statement N Kesic
Brindle with striking white markings, cracking head straight front, good body, moved ok.

2nd Orazz Deus Volt Mrs T Meeres
Another brindle with white markings, good head, and correct bite, short coupled, not much between the winner.

3rd Tullabull On A Bender G Johnson
Blue is just a bit bully for me, would have liked just a bit more height, but he did have was movement, he danced around the as though he owned.

Intermediate Dog (1)

1st Starshiraz The Hustler Mr R Mrs A Lunn
On it sown, but a very striking, red and white dog, short stop, round eyes, lovely expression, and short coupled. Just needs to relax a bit more.

State Bred Dog (4)

1st Ch Artisinal Why So Serious Mrs E Park Findlater
White with black markings, good head and expression, short body, well sprung ribs, moved exceptionally well.

2nd Starshiraz The Red Hustler S Wilkes
A very nice red, very similar to the winner, pleasant head, short back, preferred the movement on the winner.

3rd Jomaldun Polar Express C Taylor
White with strong head, correct bite, neat ears, well sprung ribcage, another who was hard to access, very unsettled.

Australian Bred Dog (6)

1st Ch Castlebar Cruize Control Mrs R Bawden

Quality brindle, superb head piece, correct bite, good rib cage, level topline on the move, well bent stifle, moved and handled well. I was pleasantly surprised to find he is the litter brother to the Best in Show winner. **R.C.C. and Reserve Best in Show**. Well done to everyone concerned in the breeding of this litter.

2nd Starshiraz Thuban Mr J Dornford & Miss R Rush

Red, pleasant head, well placed round dark eyes, straight front, level topline moved well.

3rd Leostaff Ironheart Mrs P M Rice

Dark brindle, with straight front, well shaped head, correct detention, strong rear quarters, moved well.

Open Dog (5)

1st GRD Ch Castlebar Crown Jester (AI) Mrs R Bawden

White with black markings, when he walked into the ring I wasn't impressed, then I quickly realised the markings give you a false impression. Then hands on, and I wish he was mine, what a fine specimen, well developed head, strong teeth, powerful neck correct shoulders, good rib cage, back level on the move.

Easily **Best Dog in Show**. I was later told he now holds the Australian record, 17CCs for Breed Specialists Judges. Well done.

2nd Ch Jamelkur Street E & L Birkeland

Powerful brindle, dark eyes neat eyes, good front, backend, moved well, nice dog.

3rd Ch Crossguns Jet Setter F & J Stover

Another very nice brindle, strong head, good clean bite, excellent front, correct body length, moved very nicely.

Veteran (4, 1)

1st Ch Jordistaff Domino Dealer Mrs A Leggo

When the 3 vets walked into the ring they brought a smile to my face, a pleasure to over them. Another white with black patches, classic head, lovely body, moved and, may I say handled expertly.

2nd Ch Jamelkur All Torque Mrs R Bawden

Black brindle, nicely shaped head, well boned, good rib cage excellent back end, another nice dog.

3rd Ch Stafflyte Lord O Thering Mrs P M Rice

Another old timer, who has a lot of qualities, head, front, body, but just getting on in years, thank you to all 3 dogs entered.
