BABY DOG

1st - Keltrice High Voltage

**BABY IN SHOW

Black with white chest. Correctly proportioned head with lovely round dark eyes and well placed ears. Neck of correct length, well laid back shoulders. Nice strong bone. Upright pasterns and correct east to west front. Level topline and short in loin. Well bent stifle with straight hocks when viewed from behind. Moved well.

2nd – Jinew Dream Maker

Light Brindle. Well shaped head with short muzzle, eyes of correct shape and rose ears. Short neck, no looseness in shoulders. Well boned. Correct front. Short coupled with level topline. Tail length and placement is good and hocks are parallel. Did not quite have the substance or type of the class winner.

3rd - Akinos High Voltage

Dark brindle and white. Broad deep skull of good proportions and well placed round eyes. Short neck, shoulders are ok. Topline rises slightly to the loin at this stage which can improve with age. Hocks are well let down and stifles bent. Overall a strong baby puppy class

MINOR DOG

1st - Castlebar House of Cards

**MINOR IN SHOW & MOST PROMISING PUPPY

Black and white. Correct head and muzzle ratio in length and depth with a strong under jaw. Would like to see a slightly wider muzzle as he matures. Eyes round and dark. He has a lovely scissor bite and well placed rose ears. Correct shoulder placement leading into a well boned front with broad deep chest, east to west pasterns, nice and strong short toes, nice length of back and beautiful topline. Good tail placement. Overall a dog that is really promising for the future although a little bit naughty.

PUPPY DOG

1st - Brohez Rubin Hurricane

Black with white chest. Good classic Stafford head with short muzzle. Dark eyes, well placed rose ears and scissor bite. Neck of maximum length. Shoulders are well placed and tight. Front is correct although personally I would like more bone at this stage. Topline is level and hind quarters are well muscled, although they could be slightly more bent at the stifles. On the move the tail is carried a touch high.

2nd - Bustabones Will I Am

Dark Brindle with white on chestNot as well presented as class winner, little bit timid at this stage. Decent enough head, dark round eyes, well placed ears. Teeth not fully out yet but look promising. Quite well put together but a bit light in bone. Good length of back and level topline. Could do with a little bit more bend of stifle. Short tail which was well carried.

JUNIOR DOG

"In this class neither dog moved with purpose. They were really down and had no spark. They had their heads down on the move. It was a very hot day, and that could have been a contributing factor."

1st - Ourknights Sinfully Sudi

Black brindle and white. A more classic Stafford with well-shaped and proportioned head, round dark eyes and well placed small ears with correct bite. Short neck, well laid back shoulders and well boned broad chest, good bone and east to west feet. Good length of loin with level topline. Has a well-muscled hind quarter which could have more bend of stifle.

2nd – Ourknights Simply Sinful

Black and white. Overall head shape ok but muzzle could be a touch shorter for me. Longer in leg, than the class winner. Although shoulders were tight, chest could be slightly broader with slightly better arched toes. Topline rises very slightly to a hind quarter which could have more bend of stifle.



INTERMEDIATE DOG

1st - Ch Westrova Stoic Makers Mark

**INTERMEDIATE IN SHOW

Black with white chest. Very typey little dog, beautiful shaped head with good size ears and nice round eyes. Teeth ok although his outer incisors could be slightly better. Good strong front with deep broad chest, good boning and level topline with great muscle definition. Well placed tail, hindquarters are well bent at stifle and straight when viewed from behind. Well-presented that moved well but was difficult to stack

2nd - Ch Pitford Master O Puppets

Black dog with very little white on his chest. Also a quality dog but with not as much substance as the class winner. Well-proportioned head with correct bite, lovely dark eyes and small rose ears. Short neck well placed shoulders with correct front and sufficient bone. Length to height is good with well-muscled hind quarter with good bend of stifle and parallel hocks. Moved well.

3rd - Ch Castlebar Weapon Of Choice (AI)

Black with white flash on chest. Small muscular, strong dog with a lovely head of correct shape and proportion, dark round eyes and small ears. Unfortunately the left ear is full drop and not rose. He had correct length neck, well placed muscular shoulders with correct front and lovely compact feet. He is of correct length with a level topline. He never moved as well as the others on the day being a bit close behind.

STATE BRED DOG

1st - Ch Castlebar The Confederate

**STATE BRED IN SHOW

Black dog with white on chest. He had a deep broad head with correct ratios and strong under jaw and scissor bite. Eyes are well placed and dark. Rose ears, which could be a touch smaller. Well placed shoulders, good bone and correct front. He has a short toe on left foot. He has a level topline, short loin and good hind quarters with short tail.

2nd – Keltrice X Man

Black with white chest. Head of good shape and proportions with dark round eyes and correct size rose ears. His head could be considered a touch too big for his size, apart from that he was well put together with a well assembled front, level topline and good bend of stifle.

3rd - Starshiraz The Hustler

Red and white, nice typey dog. Head of good shape and proportions with dark eyes that suit the coat colour. Well put together dog with correct front assembly, broad chest and east to west front. Good length of loin and level topline with hocks which are parallel when viewed from behind. For me this dog, although well put together could be a bit more masculine.





AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG

1st - Supreme Ch Castlebar Rise N Shine

**RESERVE CHALLENGE DOG, AUSTRALIAN BRED IN SHOW, RUNNER UP BEST IN SHOW

Black with a white chest. Broad deep head of correct shape and size. Strong underjaw and scissor bite. Nice short neck going into well placed shoulders with a lovely chest. Good bone and compact east to west feet. Topline level with short coupled loin. Muscular hind quarter with a short well placed tail could possible do with a bit more bend of stifle. This dog moved well and was presented in outstanding condition.

2nd - Ch Sookalott The Heartbreaker

Black with slight white spot on chest. Slightly taller than the class winner. This dog has a well-shaped head with good ratios and round eyes which could possibly be darker on such a dark dog. He has the correct length neck and well placed shoulders. On the day his front feet didn't appear to stand in an east to west position although his toes were compact. He has a level topline, is short coupled and has well bent stifles.

3rd - Tiagra The Furyan

Black with white chest. Nice typey dog with a lovely classic head although the left ear is a bit weak. Teeth are correct. He has a well laid back shoulders with a good front and east to west feet. He has a level topline and short loin. Unfortunately his rear toes seemed a bit long and he appeared to stand flat footed lacking arch in his toes.

OPEN DOG

1st - Ch Artisinal Why So Serious

** CHALLENGE DOG. OPEN IN SHOW & BEST IN SHOW

Pied dog, in my opinion a very classic Stafford, with a head being broad and deep with prominent cheeks and a distinct stop. Round dark eyes, with good pigmentation for a dog with so much white. Small thin rose ears which are well placed and a correct scissor bite. Neck of correct length with well laid back tight shoulders going into a correct front with a deep broad chest with plenty of bone and strong pasterns. His feet turn out just enough to be east to west. He has a lovely level topline and short loin, a well-muscled hind quarter which is well bent at the stifle with hocks which are parallel when viewed from behind. He has a well-placed pump handle tail. This dog also moved very well showing reach, drive and parallel movement. It was a pleasure to judge him.

2nd - Castlebar Full Metal Jacket (AI)

Brindle with small white spot on chest. Also a very well put together dog, a bit unfortunate that he came up against the dog it did, as he could have won a lot of the other classes. He had a head of good shape and proportion with round eyes which matched its coat. Well placed rose ears and correct scissor bite. Good length neck, good shoulders, correct front with deep broad chest. Level topline and short loin. Well placed tail with muscular hind quarters and well bent stifle. Also moved well.

3rd - Ch Farrugastaff Red Temper

Red smut with white chest. Head of good overall shape but could be stronger in muzzle. Ears are a bit strong but still rose. He had a short neck, tight shoulders, correct front with strong bone and deep broad chest. Short coupled dog. Hind quarters are muscular but could have more bend of stifle. Overall I felt he could be slightly fitter.

VETERAN DOG

1st - Supreme Ch Castlebar Crown Jester (AI)

**VETERAN IN SHOW

Pied dog of good type and substance. Head being of good shape and proportions with dark eyes. Teeth are good for a dog of his age. He had well placed shoulders, lovely bone and a correct front. He is unfortunately showing his age in the rear, lacking slightly in hind quarter and limping on the day.

2nd - Ch Crossguns Jet Setter (Imp UK)

Black brindle with white chest. Head of good shape and proportions with dark round eyes and well placed rose ears. Still has the correct scissor bite. He was unfortunately out at elbow and was lacking in muscularity at this stage of his life. He also didn't move as well as he could have in the rear.



NEUTER DOG

1st - Akinos The Snowman

**NEUTER DOG CHALLENGE & NEUTER IN SHOW

White dog of good type. Head is of correct overall shape and proportion with tight lips. He has dark round eyes with good pigmentation on eyelids and lips. He's neck is of maximum length with well-placed shoulders and a correct front. He has a short loin and well placed tail. This dog needs to lose weight and increase fitness.

BABY BITCH

1st - Jinew Dreaming Of You

Brindle. Feminine little head of good shape with dark eyes and rose ears. Short neck, good bone, east to west front, correct length of loin and good bend of stifle. She was presented in good condition.

2nd - Akinos High Velocity

Black Brindle and white. Head of good basic shape with dark well placed eyes. Short neck and east to west front. She is short coupled but at this stage her tail set is a bit high and did not move as well

MINOR BITCH

"Neither bitch had an ideal topline on the move at this stage of their development."

1st - Castlebar A Dance With Dragons

Black and white. Broad deep head with dark round eyes, well placed ears and correct bite. Well placed shoulders with plenty of bone, a deep chest and east to west front. Topline rising to the hind quarter on the move at this stage.

2nd - Castlebar Hide The Halo

Black and white. Lovely shape head with good ratio's. Dark eyes and rose ears. Canines are still developing at present but looks promising. No looseness in shoulders with wide chest and east to west front. On the day the topline was a bit roached while moving.

PUPPY BITCH

1st - Goodfella Special Request

**PUPPY IN SHOW

Little Brindle and white bitch of beautiful feminine type. This bitch had the strongest head piece in the class, having a very well-proportioned and shaped head, dark eyes and scissor bite. She has well placed shoulders, good bone and east to west feet. She is short coupled with good bend at the stifle, moved well when handler got her going. Although I liked the bitch I think the owner has to put some work into training and socialising if she wants to do well in the future.

2nd - Leostaff Storm Ryder

Brindle. Although head is feminine with dark round eyes, rose ears and scissor bite, I would like to see more width and depth in the muzzle. Neck is of correct length, shoulders are well laid back with nice boning and correct chest. She was short coupled with a level topline and parallel hocks when viewed from behind .

3rd - Castlebar Talking In Tongues

Black. This bitch was slightly longer on leg than the other two and had slightly less substance in relation to height. Although head was well proportioned with dark round eyes her ears are on the longer side. Teeth were correct. Neck is of correct length with no looseness in shoulders giving her a deep chest and east to west front. She had a short loin and level topline, moved well coming and going.



JUNIOR BITCH

1st – Westrova Flirt In A Skirt

**CHALLENGE BITCH, JUNIOR IN SHOW

Pied. This bitch has the perfect balance between femininity and substance. Lovely broad deep head with good ratio's. Strong cheek muscles and distinct stop. She has dark round eyes with good pigmentation. Small well placed rose ears and scissor bite. Neck of correct length, good shoulder placement, deep broad chest with lovely substance and bone. Her topline is level and loin short. She has muscular hind quarters with enough bend of stifle and straight hocks. She also moved well coming and going.

2nd - Sonique Sirius Star

White Bitch. Very similar type to class winner. This bitch also had a head that was very well shaped and proportioned. Eyes were dark and round with a fair amount of pigmentation. Ears were small, rose and well placed. She also had a correct bite. She had a correct length neck, tight shoulders, lovely front and good bone and substance. Height to length ratio was correct and she moved well. Her topline is just not quite as strong as the first place bitch.

3rd - Keltrice Xenotime

Black and white. This bitch's head piece was not as strong as the other two although it was well shaped with dark round eyes and rose ears. Shoulders were good with a chest of sufficient depth. She was a well put together bitch with level topline, well placed tail and good bend of stifle but unfortunately never had the balance of substance and femininity of the other two.

INTERMEDIATE BITCH

1st - Ch Sookalott Alice in Wonderland

Brindle with white flash on chest. Very feminine bitch. Head of good overall size and proportions, scissor bite with strong under jaw, round dark eye and well placed rose ears. Good front with compact feet. Level top line with well-placed tail and good bend of stifle.

2nd - Ashahara Ainobody Gotime Fodat (AI)

Black with white chest. Head of good basic shape with dark round eyes and rose ears. Teeth ok but not perfect, under jaw could be a bit stronger. Shoulders and chest good with good length of neck. Topline roached a bit when moving, but hindquarter well muscled with good bend of stifle

3rd - Benshire All Eyes On Me

Brindle with small white patch on chest. This bitch has got a broad deep head of good proportion. Her eyes are dark and round, ears are rose but slightly large and she lacks the femininity of the other two. She has a deep chest, east to west feet. She was slightly long in loin compared to the other two and never moved quite as well as them.





STATE BRED BITCH

1st - Akinos Charming The Storm

**RESERVE CHALLENGE BITCH

Brindle with white flash on chest. Overall good type bitch. Well balanced head with correct skull to muzzle ratio. Lovely dark round eyes and well placed ears although slightly on the large side. She has a correct scissor bite. This bitch also had a Short neck and well placed shoulders giving her a lovely strong front which is well boned. She has a level top line viewed from behind. Moved well going around.

2nd - Tiagra The One And Only

Black Brindle. Very classic looking Stafford head of correct shape having round eyes and thin rose ears which could be smaller. She has a strong under jaw and scissor bite. Shoulders are well laid back and she has a lovely chest. Her feet turned enough to be east to west. Topline is level and loin short. I would be careful of the way you stack her as her hocks were turned in once or twice while judging.

3rd - Ch Castlebar I Spy (AI)

Black Brindle, good head shape of good ratios with round dark eyes and well placed ears. Bite could be slightly better. Neck is of correct length, shoulders are tight with a well boned front and deep chest. Topline and length was ok, although she is overweight and also stood cow hocked on occasion. Did not move as well as other class winners.

AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH

1st - Vanstaff Tomasina

Black brindle with white on chest of good type. Head of good shape and size, dark round eyes, small rose ears with correct scissor bite. Neck of correct length with well-placed shoulders and good fore chest. East to west feet. She has a level topline well angled hind quarters and good tail length. Moved well. Being super critical she could be a touch shorter in loin.

2nd - Ch Artisinal The Pawn Queen

Pied bitch with good balance of substance and femininity. Head of good shape and proportion. Well placed round dark eyes and rose ears. Pigment fairly good on white side of face and very good on lips. She has good shoulder placement with a lovely front and level topline. She stood slightly cow hocked on the day and never moved as well as the class winner.

3rd - Ourknights Safira Thasungoddess

Red. She has a head with good depth of skull and muzzle, dark eyes for the red colour and rose ears, correct scissor bit. She had a deep chest and east to west feet and well sprung ribs. She also presented slightly cow hocked and never moved as well as the class winner on the day.

OPEN BITCH

1st - Ch Brohez Black Art

Little black and white bitch. This bitch had a lovely shaped head of correct shape and proportions for her size. She has well placed round dark eyes, a scissor bite and rose ears. Her neck is of maximum length leading into well placed shoulders with a deep broad chest and east to west feet. She has a level topline and short loin. For me she could do with a slight bit more bend of stifle.

2nd - Ch Castlebar Believe It Or Not

Black Brindle bitch. She has a head of good depth and breadth with good proportions and a scissor bite. Her eyes are round and dark, ears are small, thin and rose. She has a good short neck, tight shoulders, deep chest and east tp west feet. She has a level topline and muscular hindquarters and straight hocks when viewed from behind. She just never quite had the femininity of the class winner.

3rd – Ourknights Fire Goddess

Red with little white flash on chest. She has a well-shaped head with a lovely dark mask on her muzzle, dark round eyes, a scissor bite and well placed rose ears. She was well boned with compact east to west feet. She has a fairly good topline although her tail placement was slightly high and she could have slightly bit more bend of stifle.



VETERAN BITCH

1st - Grand Ch Castlebar Strip Search (AI)

Black with White chest. Youngest of the 3 of good type but could be considered a little bit masculine. Still has a good head shape, dark eyes and a scissor bite. Good front, good depth of chest, correct height to length ratio's and level topline with well bent stifle and straight hocks when viewed from behind and moved well for her age.

2nd - Grand Ch Crossguns Lady Madonna (Imp UK)

Brindle bitch with white flash on her chest. More feminine, also lots of virtues. Good head type, good topline and moved well. Unfortunately she is a little bit undershot at this stage in life. Good length of back, hocks were nice and straight also would have been a good bitch in her day

3rd - Ch Tothemax Cry Me A River

Brindle bitch with white chest. Oldest of the lot, 11 years old, she's got a lot of breed virtues. Dark round eyes, good bend of stifle and good length of back. I think in her day she would have been a very typey bitch. She has unfortunately lost all muscle and was battling a bit with the heat but I think years ago would have been a lovely girl. Would have liked to seen her then.

NEUTER BITCH

1st - Castlebar Wish Upon A Star

**NEUTER CHALLENGE BITCH

Black and white bitch greying in the face. She is a bit tall on leg, lacking a bit of width in her head. She has well placed rose ears and scissor bite. She has a good front and chest, slightly long in loin but forgivable, level topline, good tailset, presented in good condition.

2nd - Belladog Bonnie Matilda

Red and white bitch. Good overall head shape with eyes that match her coat. Ear placement is a bit wide, she has a scissor bite. She has a deep broad chest and east to west feet. She was of good length to height ratio with good bend of stifle. Unfortunately she was a bit timid in the ring and could do with building confidence.



Brindle, excellent pigmentation, sweet expression, moved ok for age.

2nd - Akinos High Velocity

Black with white shirt, younger than 1st but moved better, even though she was a bit fidgety.

"Both these babies should have a good future in the show ring."

MINOR BITCH

1st - Castlebar Hide The Halo

**MINOR IN SHOW

Black with white marking, good mouth, neat ears, neat feet, dark eye in fact good pigmentation all round. Moved well should do well when she matures.

2nd - Castlebar A Dance With Dragons

Out of the same kennel, feet not so neat, movement ok, just hope she makes the size.

PUPPY BITCH

1st - Trueblend No Ordinary Affair

Lovely black brindle, moved and handled very well, excellent pigmentation, good mouth neat well set ears, liked her.

2nd - Leostaff Storm Ryder

Brindle, her expression was not as feminine as I would have liked, although she had a good dark eye and neat ears, moved ok.

3rd - Magicmine Dukes Angel

Black brindle, liked her head shape, ears neat, dark eye just didn't moved as 1st and 2nd for me.

JUNIOR BITCH

1st - Keltrice Xenotime

Black/white markings, nice head, dark eye, good mouth, neat feet, moved well keeping a level topline.

2nd - Sonique Sirius Star

Pied, similar comments as one, although feet need to tighten up, moved well.

3rd - Ch Westrova Flirt In A Skirt

Black and white pied, slightly longer cast than one, nice head, dark eye, good mouth, moved well.

INTERMEDIATE BITCH

1st - Ch Sookalott Alice in Wonderland

Brindle good expression, dark eye, neat ear, good mouth, moved very well.

2nd - Starshiraz Demis Rose

Red bitch, wasn't happy to start with but when settled she showed herself well, muzzle dark as were her eyes, neat ears, moved well.

3rd - Ashahara Ainobody Gotime Fodat (AI)

Black bindle/white marking, topline not so good, back movement not her strong point, shames as the rest of her was good.

STATE BRED BITCH

1st - Tiagra The One And Only

Lovely dark brindle, good pigmentation, nice expression, good mouth, neat well placed ears, showed well when handled got sorted!

2nd - Akinos Charming The Storm

Not so dark as one, pretty expression, feet not so neat (well one of them), moved well.

3rd - Ch Castlebar I Spy (AI)

In the middle of a phantom (don't they always do it when a show is coming up!), this aside, her ears were ok as was her mouth, although some of her nails need attention, moved ok.

AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH

1st - Ch Artisinal The Pawn Queen

**RESERVE CHALLENGE BITCH, AUSTRALIAN BRED IN SHOW

Pied, super head, good expression, pigmentation good, nice topline held on the move, liked her.


